REGIONAL RACE/ORO/RACE COMMITTEE – Paul Einarson, RR/ORO/RC Director:

Regional Race: Paul has a written report for the recorder

- We're at the end of the Region race season and again, Paul thanked those volunteers and competitors that helped BARC and other Clubs run a successful season
- We have no word yet on a 2014 schedule. We do know that HIT will be one week later than in previous years, and that that earlier date will be occupied by the Tudor United Sports Car Championship event at CTMP
- As it stands now, we would like to replicate the 2013 season dates. This means that for some of you, it will mean working 4 events in 5 weeks, including the pro events. If some

of you work Security for what I assume will be the Civic Holiday and Boots & Hearts Concert, it will mean 5 events in 6 weeks. This compression is stressful

- Nick Majors, our Regional Race Director and I have been unable to date to meet with Myles Brandt, at his request, despite giving Myles numerous dates of availability. In addition to discussing 2014 dates, he wants to show us and no doubt sell us on the new 1.6 mile short track. When we do meet, I am not sure what we will be faced with. This may be a sales pitch for the new track, or it could be an ultimatum for BARC and BEMC that you get one long and one short track date for Myles to free long track dates for other customers
- Paul has a number of concerns about the short track that include: the facilities that will be available; the ability of MMS to Marshal two events on the same weekend; the price structure; the entry fee level; and the gate fee issue. All of this needs to be discussed with CTMP.
- -There was a reminder that Shannonville is a big track and there's no gate fee. Accommodations for volunteers is an extra cost
 - Paul needs some direction from the members as to where to go as a Club. They have said before that they don't want to return to Shannonville as an alternative venue. If we are faced with the alternative of one long and one short track event how do you feel about it?
- -. Bryan Rashleigh and Bill Lobban said that drivers would prefer to race on the big track, not the small track.
 - Pau reported some benefits to a short track event that include: potentially cheaper rent (most other costs would be the same, except for negotiation on the gate fee); the first few events on the short track would likely attract large entries to try it out, and after that some thinning would occur; if we kept entry fees the same, short track revenues could subsidize escalating costs at the long track; we could likely have our pick of 2014 dates, to relieve some of the congestion BARC volunteers are experiencing at CTMP
- -Some questions and discussion from the members included: price; gate fee; will there be a control tower, a medical facility, washrooms/showers; marshals' stations, food available for competitors, results, radio room, etc.

ORO: Not much to report

Race Committee: Mary Lobban reports:

- Mary wasn't at the last meeting and hasn't seen any Minutes, therefore cannot speak to what was discussed there

- The fire accident study is still underway Laurence will report to the Safety Committee at CASC, and results will likely remain public (it will be CASC's decision what to report)
- She reported that the Celebration weekend was a success. The weather was great. Volunteer workers were each given a \$25 Esso gift card, and Kijiji gave everyone t-shirts. Attendance was good around 120 entries. There was one nasty accident where a driver was taken to hospital. He later posted on his Facebook site that he received broken ribs.
