Regional Race: Paul has a written report for the recorder

- Paul has been negotiating with a US Radical Racing group, based in the Las Vegas area, to bring the US Radical Cup to our July 26-27/14 event. He gave them the track time available, and prices for the July event. Yesterday, they confirmed that they will be at the BARC July event
- A new F2000 group has been started by Jason Sharpe, and has enquired about a separate series race at our June event, and not with FLibre.
- There will not be a DAC event in 2014, due to financial results from the May event, and their inability to secure an alternative date that would work. That leaves a 7 week gap between Race 1 and Race 2. Paul was asked to contact CTMP about the possibility of a race on the new short track, either the last or 2nd last weekend in May, in an attempt to fill that gap. Myles had originally said that those dates were taken, then said he would see what he could do about rearranging the schedule, and get back to him. He has not yet, despite Paul's attempt to follow up with him.
