The General Competition Rules have been updated.

In the GT Sprint Series, in car timing is no longer restricted.

SFI seatbelts are no longer valid for five years and must be replaced every two years.

After passing a marshal's station displaying a yellow flag, drivers are not allowed to start racing until they pass the next station displaying a green flag. This will make it safer for workers on track.

Blocking while racing has been clarified and may be judged by officials based on changing your line in reaction to a move from the vehicle behind, or perhaps taking an unusual racing line.

Tom Cressman reported that the fire training would take place on the weekend of May 8th. Extrication, fire and First Aid training will be covered. It will be held at Abrams Towing at 124 Lepage Court in North York.

There will be two Race Division series participating in a joint event with the Time Attack Series on June 24th, 25th. BARC for a nominal fee will assist with running the event. We will run Staff Services, Grids, Race Control etc., for the Formula Libre and GT Sprint Series.

BARC will also have their race event on July 29 and 30th. The Ferrari Forza Series will participate with a group of approximately 20 cars. There will also be a Sundown endurance race ending at sunset on Saturday night.
