## **Regional Race:**

- With this year being the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Formula Vee racing, we made a deal with the F1200 Group that if they can attract non-CASC-OR competitors to come join their race in July and celebrate the Anniversary, we would charge on 50% of the entry fee. They have been doing some marketing, but I actually doubt we will see many entries.
- There have been communication problems with Radio from the new event centre to corners 4 & 8, and Pace Car difficulties through 5 7. Bob Stiver reported similar problems to the BEMC weekend at their Victoria Day event. Francos, of Racing Radios contacted the Starter and the Race Director for NASCAR, and they reported no problems. I will be doing some tests with Racing Radios on Friday. We will have an antenna and base stations for Control and a base station for the Pace Car, if problems persist.
- The June event has 2 Challenge races, one on each of the two days.
- I have reached out for sponsorship of the Breakfast for volunteers, with no result yet
- F1600 promotion via Diane Dale will be present for the June race. Trophy presentations, start your engines call, and start of one or both of the F1600 races by a sponsor up on the Starter Stand, at the direction of the Starter, will occur, along with a photographer at the Pit Wall and elsewhere, except at the Start of races.
- If you hear anything funny at the June race, please email it to me. I have done a bit on "funny things overheard at the track" for the newsletter, but need more material
- We are still looking for someone to photograph the Podium for the sponsors, from 2 5pm on Sunday, and for the F1600 race for Saturday
