REGIONAL RACE/ORO/RACE COMMITTEE – Paul Einarson, RR/ORO/RC Director:

ORO - The Committee is working on its 2013 Race Schedule, but is not getting much cooperation from CTMP

- They are booking 2 concerts for next summer one for the August Long Weekend, and the other for Labour Day
- BEMC and DAC want the same dates they always have, and MCO want to stage an event in 2013 not sure when
- ORO made a controversial decision: 4 Clubs and Celebration will be required to host Libre cars at 1 of their events, as a minimum, which means there could be only 5 events
- There is also a big push on by the Competitors for having 100 minutes of track time for each series – Paul believes there could be huge liability implications if events occur that reduce track time, and the organizing Club would have to refund entry fees – Clubs could go bankrupt

RACE COMMITTEE -

 A decision about rain lights has finally been made. FIA approved rain lights only, and if fuel cells present, the feeder lines will have to be enclosed. The announcement will be made at the Drivers' Meeting at the CASC Annual General Meeting

GT Challenge -

- For 2013, classes will be determined by a Formula of Basic Horsepower to Weight, with additional consideration of modifications, rather than speed brackets.
- Paul also understood that there will not be breakouts for GT Challenge
- Paul has asked for details about the impact to Clubs –what are the new classes?
- New Trophies will be required, as well as new tools for Scrutineers who will be responsible for ensuring compliance drivers, clubs, or CASC?
- There was a suggestion about Clubs charging a surcharge to pay for Challenge Dynos and other compliance equipment
- There were many other issues at both the ORO and Race Committee about managing the sport, but many of them are unlikely to interest this group
- Paul asked if Bill or Mary Lobban, who sit on the Race Committee, had anything else to add to the discussion

Bill and Mary added:

- There will likely be GT, GS, and 3 street tuner Classes
- There had been discussion among the drivers about the timing of the Drivers' Meetings at the track are they necessary? drivers want them to be held first thing Saturday morning. The problem with lunch meetings is that the group that's first to go out right after the meeting end up being late
- There will be a complete revision to an Appendix regarding how Driver Schools are being run
- Tow eyes/straps have either come apart or were broken while being towed out of difficult places
- Dave King reminded about a new CASC series held years ago, and that when the organizing Clubs have no responsibility for a race they are responsible for running, it is NOT acceptable to the Clubs
- Bill believes that compliance has to be a driver's responsibility, to comply with whatever the rules state. The GT Challenge is a group of drivers, and to have them decide which class somebody else should run in is NOT a good idea, either. CASC and the Clubs must make those decisions.
- There was much discussion about having to have a dyno machine at the track, or having certain auto shops (Canadian Tire?) have CASC approved dyno machines In a power to weight ratio, 2-3 lbs off will not make a differences
- The drivers instigated this change, as a tool for preventing sandbagging

At this point in the meeting, Bryan and Marlene Rashleigh arrived. It was decided that the General Meeting would continue and the AGM would be held at its conclusion.
